1. 100% of the allocated budget of Rs 67.41 mn has been utilized by Nalanda under this scheme
2. Placement ratio is based on candidates trained and is higher this year on account of concerted placement efforts by the training partners
3. Placement is expected to increase to atleast 2100 by April-May 2017 implying a higher placement ratio of 86%
4. **UMTC's stake of contribution to the skilling programme pool is Rs 3.52 mn (5.22%)**

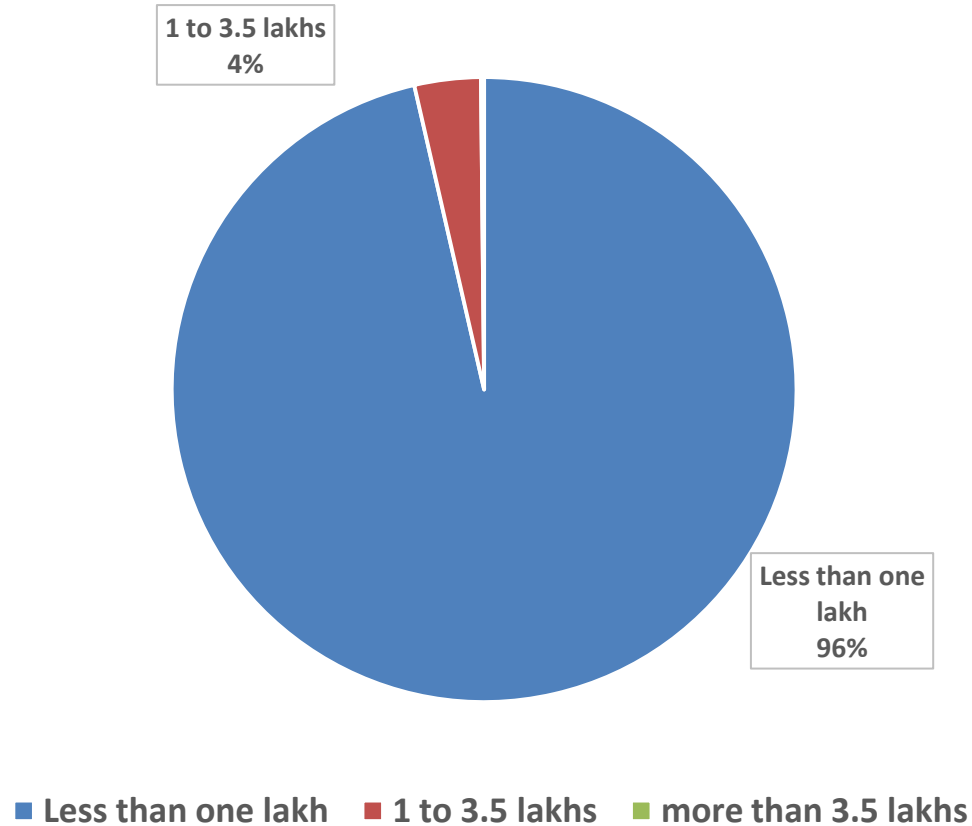

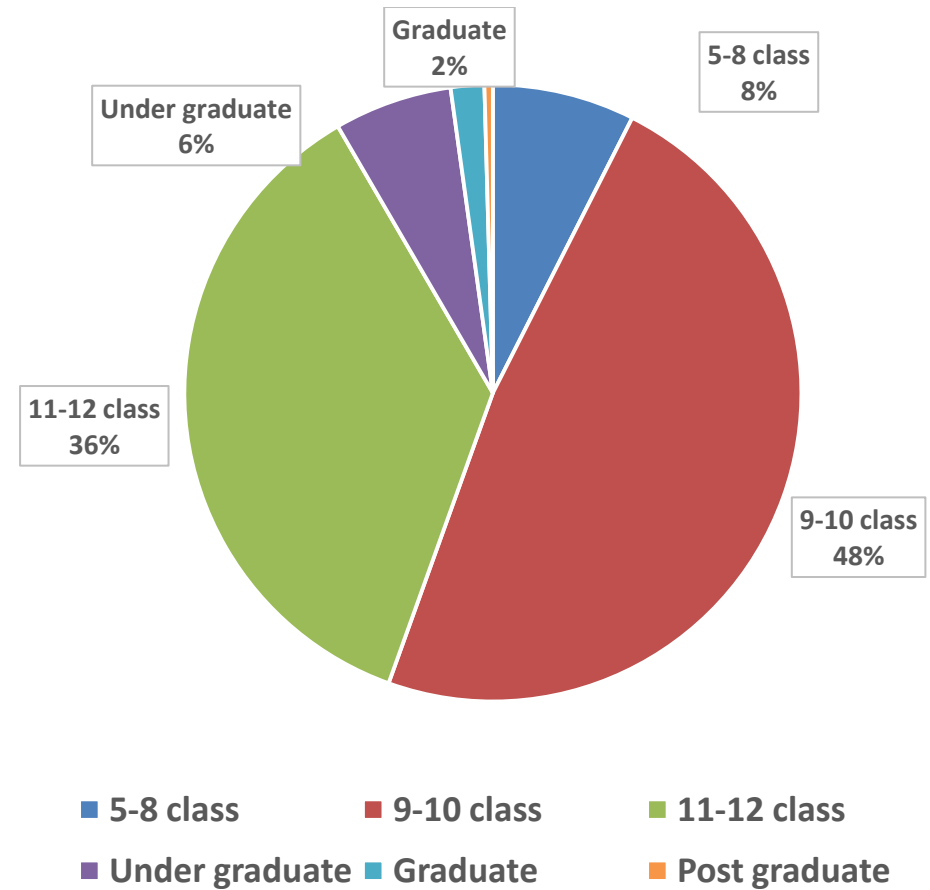

Annual HH Income-wise Distribution*



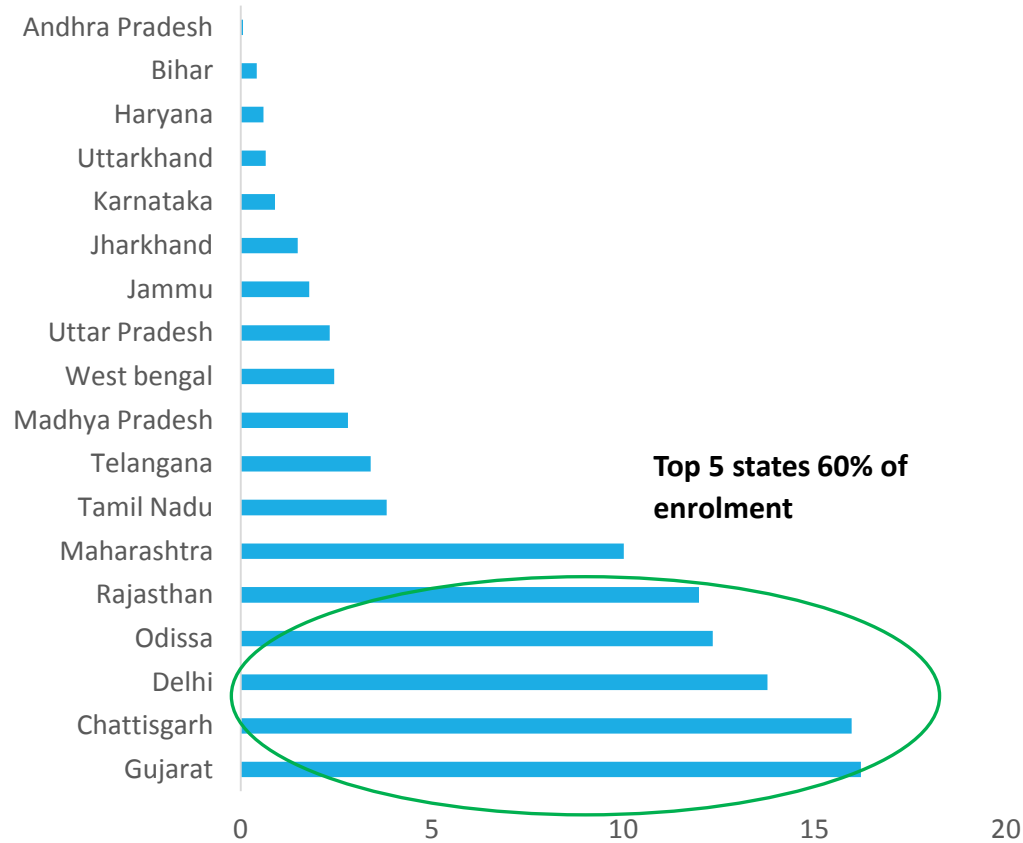
Educational Background of the Candidates*



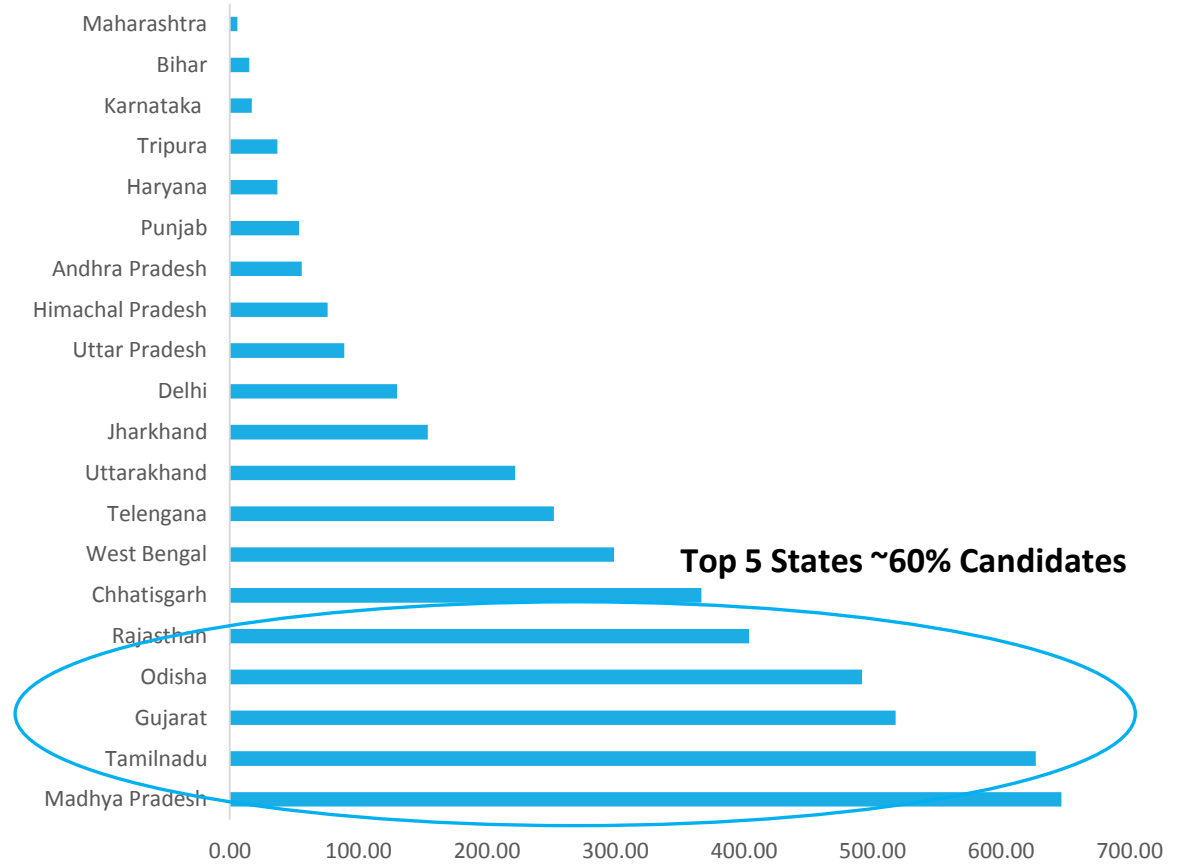
The scheme continues to cater to the low income, relatively educated, unemployed youth

State-wise Analysis of Enrolled Candidates* FY '16

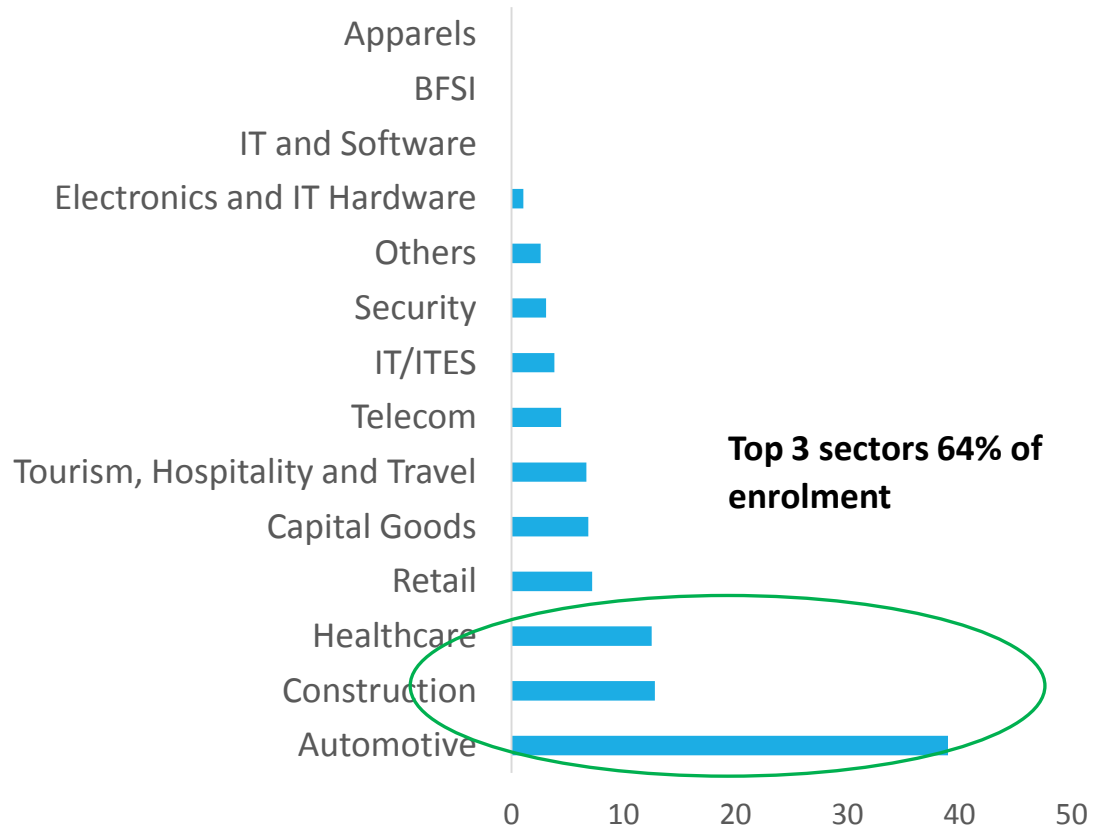


Top states for mobilization continue to include Rajasthan, Odisha, Gujarat

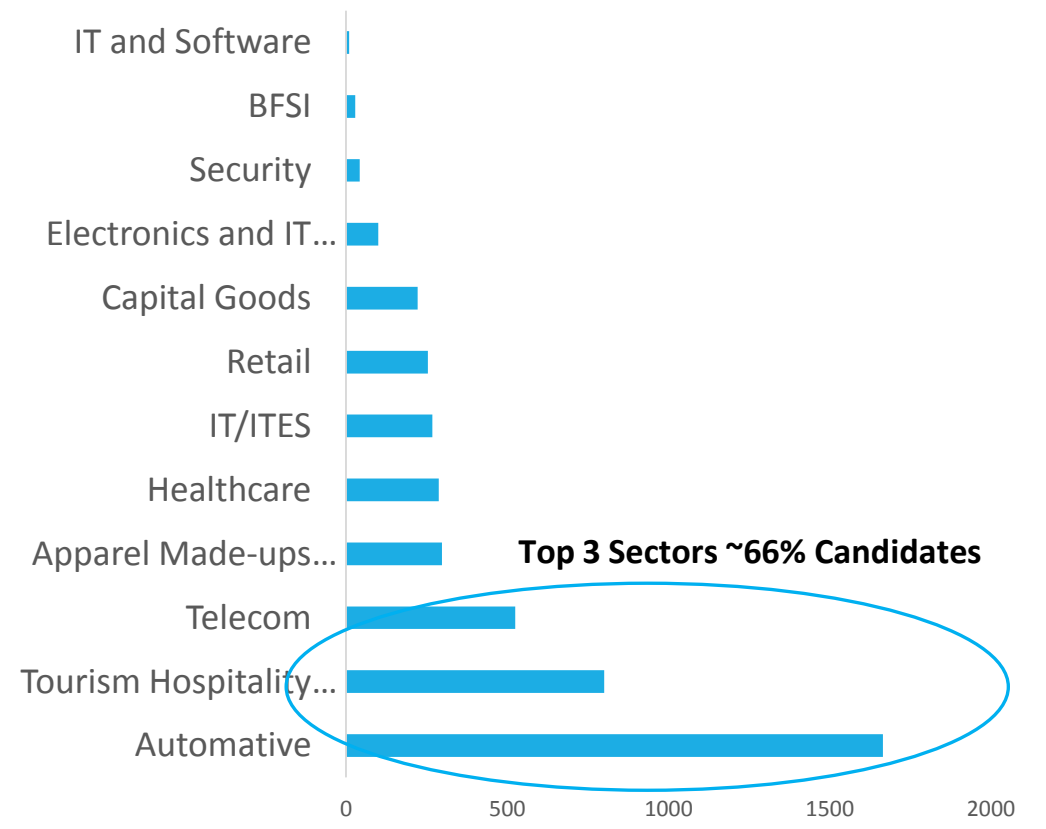
More than half of the candidates have been identified from IL&FS catchments (previous year about one third)
